HOW TO BOOK

Simple. Complete the booking form in this brochure and send it, together with the appropriate deposit, to your Travel Agent. We'll do the rest. Bon Voyage!

INCLUDED IN FARE

Transportation, ferries, services of Driver and Courier, road taxes, tolls, 3rd Party insurance (Europe only), use of camping equipment, city tours, and excursions as indicated.

NOT INCLUDED IN FARE

Unless otherwise stated visa costs, personal insurance, food and/or accommodation expenses (outside of food and/or accommodation fund cover), independent sightseeing, museum entrances, guide fees, tips, personal expenses, optional excursions.

Police Escort Charge: Sometimes the Iranian authorities insist on a police escort. If so, a charge of approximately US\$10 per person is payable to the Courier.

Iran: If an Iranian visa is not obtainable, or the political situation is such that entry would be inadvisable, an overflight would be necessary at an extra cost to yourself.

SPENDING MONEY

By western standards overland travel is still inexpensive. In order to cover snack lunches, souvenirs, etc you should carry an average of £6 (US\$10) per day extra to any food/accommodation fund figure quoted. It is best to carry Sterling or US\$ Travellers' Cheques, plus a small amount of cash in American dollars (small denominations).

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD FUND

This amount is shown at the top of every Tour explanation and is collected by the Courier at the start of the tour. It pays for all accommodation and food (except food in hotels if not included in tariff). All such meals and lunches are paid for separately by you. The fund is jointly supervised by the Courier and a passenger, and any surplus is divided amongst everyone at the end of the tour. It's a good system which allows accurate budgeting and the benefit of group rates. The western sectors of these tours are all camping, but convert to modest hotels through Egypt, Israel and Asia.

BAGGAGE - WHAT TO BRING

One small lockable suitcase, approximately 61cm x 41cm x 21cm, plus a small airways bag, sleeping bag and air mattress. Total weight 20kg (44lb). Alternatively, a rucksack of similar dimensions with removable frame. Sorry but no larger luggage or suitcase wheels. Sleeping bags are needed on hotel tours too.

INSURANCE

We cover you for 3rd Party insurance in Europe only. As Passenger Liability is restricted or unavailable in many countries outside Europe, it is mandatory that you take out adequate personal insurance, which can be arranged through your Travel Agent. If you arrange it yourself, stress it is for an overland tour.

VISAS

Visas are still needed for many countries. Our Visa Service obtains these for you in advance where possible (details, costs, etc come with booking confirmation), but some visas must be obtained en route. Carry eight passport photographs.

HEALTH

You must have a valid certificate of vaccination against cholera and typhoid, duly stamped by a recognised Vaccination Centre or local Health Authority. Cholera inoculation must be with two injections, and less than three months old. Hepatitis inoculation is also recommended. Malaria tablets are also a necessity, as is a mild but effective anti-diarrhoeal mixture.

CAMPING EQUIPMENT

We supply everything except your sleeping bag, air mattress, plate, cup, knife, fork and spoon.

COURIERS AND DRIVERS

Your Couriers and Drivers are easy to get along with. They have both been specifically trained for these types of tours. The Courier in particular becomes more important as each day goes by. He is guide, interpreter, medical orderly, trouble shooter, food expert, story teller and friend, but not to the extent of being your nursemaid.

IMPORTANT

Himalayan trips are alternatives to the regimented coach tours. As on any long journey there are occasional discomforts, and local facilities are sometimes primitive. You must be prepared to accept such conditions. If you are in any doubt as to your ability to do this, please reconsider, and thus avoid spoiling the trip for others.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

A deposit of £50 per person must be made at the time of booking. This deposit is accepted as part of the inclusive fare and will only be refunded if the applicant cannot be offered a place on the tour.

The accepted applicant will pay the balance of the inclusive fare no later than 30 days before the published departure date of the tour.

If prior to 30 days before the published departure date the applicant wishes to transfer from the tour he/she has booked, a transfer fee equal to half the deposit is required. Transfers of less than 30 days cannot be accepted without loss of moneys contracted, unless the vacated place is subsequently filled.

If the balance of all moneys due to the operator is not paid 30 days prior to departure, the operator may treat the booking as cancelled by the client.

If the client cancels his/her booking less than 30 days before the published departure date the balance of moneys can only be refunded if the cancelled place is subsequently filled.

Clients will effect personal travel insurance, being satisfied that their insurance cover fully meets their personal requirements.

All passengers are advised to take out an insurance cover against cancellation on medical grounds.

Tour prices and itineraries quoted are subject to alteration without previous notice due to any change in exchange rates, fares, timetables, etc. Unless otherwise stated the charges include: Transportation, ferry fares, taxes, services of Company representative s, use of camping equipment.

Unless otherwise stated the charges do not include meals, passports and visas, laundry, optional excursions, personal spending money, accommodation and campsite fees.

The conveyance of passengers, their baggage and personal property throughout the tour is subject to the terms and conditions of the carriers used. In accepting the seat the passenger agrees to the terms and conditions of the carriers.

If, for any reason, the whole or part of the tour is cancelled by the Management, the Management's only liability will be the refund of any money paid by passengers less the cost of any services already provided.

Each passenger shall be bound by any cancellation or alteration made under the provisions of this clause and shall not be entitled to recover any sum paid by him/her unless the whole tour can be cancelled by the Management before departure date.

Passengers will comply strictly with all Customs and Foreign Exchange restrictions of the countries visited. Should any contravention be detected at any Frontier or by the Company the passenger may be asked to leave the tour without right of refund of any fare or other payment made. Passengers will accept the authority and decisions of the tour leader/s appointed by the Management.
